Botanical Field Visit by BSc Students

On 12th September 2025, B.Sc. students of Semesters 1, 3, & 5 from SSCC went on a field visit to two institutes of GEER Foundation: Aranya Udhyan and Ecological Research Laboratory of Indroda Park in Gandhinagar.

At the Udhyan, the students learned a few things about the amazing butterflies in the butterfly park. Students also observed the diverse flora of the park and witnessed a model of the Miyawaki Forest. Post that, the students explored different laboratories, like Biology, Scanning Electron Microscopy (SEM), Environmental Testing, Gas Chromatography (GC), HPLC, Atomic Absorption Spectroscopy (AAS), Total Organic Carbon (TOC), and Microbial Analysis.
